The \$1,000.00 Lucy Covington Fellows Scholarship is available for the 2023-24 school year. This scholarship was created to support American Indian/Alaska Native scholars in their pursuit of a college education.

Students applying for this scholarship must meet the following criteria:

1. Students may be from any academic discipline.
2. Students must be entering their Junior or Senior undergraduate year or at the Graduate level.
3. Students must be in good academic standing with a cumulative GPA of 2.8 or greater.
4. Students must submit an essay addressing the following (in no more than three pages):
  - What is the reason(s) for your academic major?
  - Tell us about any significant activities, involvement and awards including community service and/or leadership roles.
  - What are your goals and plans for the future?
  - What are the characteristics of Lucy Covington that will inspire you and/or impact your career?
5. Student must be an American Indian/Alaska Native citizen of a federally recognized tribe and provide proof of citizenship by submitting one of the following documents:
  - Enrollment identification card (color copy of front and back of card)
  - Certificate of Indian Blood
  - Letter of descendency (if enrollment is not available to student)

In order to apply for the scholarship, the following materials must be submitted to Eastern Washington University, Office of the President, Tribal Nations Advisory Council postmarked on or before **Monday, August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023**.

1. The application form, completed and with the applicant's signature;
2. Proof of citizenship/descendency/shareholder status in a federally recognized tribe or Alaska Native Corporation/Village (refer to the list of acceptable identification above in number 5).
3. The essay in requirement number 4, see above.
4. Academic transcripts for all college level work. Unofficial transcripts are acceptable.
