45 minutes to skiing and snowboarding (five mountain ranges to choose from!)

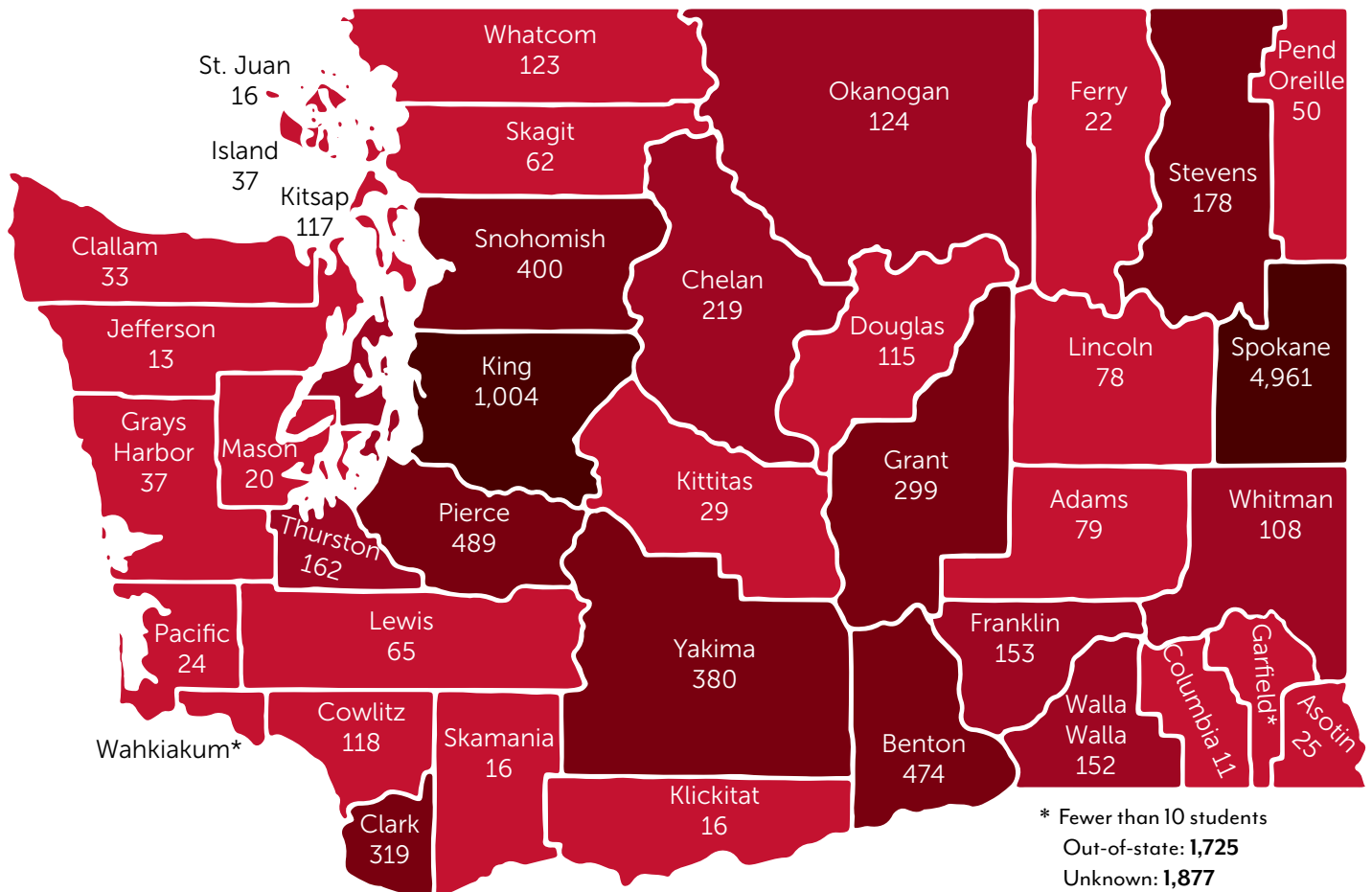
