Keynote Speaker

AMY NUÑEZ, PHD Education Policy



EWU McNair Alumna, Amy Nuñez, Ph.D, received her Bachelor's in Elementary Education at Eastern in 2015 and her Ph.D. in Education Policy from Indiana University, Bloomington in 2023. Her dissertation titled, "I Wish They Knew We Existed": The Academic Experiences of Latinx College Students in Mixed-Status Families, won third place in the Outstanding Dissertation Competition hosted by the American Association of Hispanics in Higher Education in 2024. This research identified equitable strategies to better support students in mixed-status families achieve their higher education goals. Dr. Nuñez's research utilizes qualitative methods with Critical Race Theory (CRT) and Latino Critical Theory (LatCrit) to address barriers historically underrepresented students face in higher education institutions, especially students who come from Latinx, low-income, first-generation, DACA, and/ or undocumented backgrounds. Her research aims to develop mitigation strategies to increase enrollment and graduation rates among underrepresented student populations. She currently works as an Assistant Professor at Heritage University in the Teacher Preparation Program. As a first-generation college student, Latina, and daughter of immigrants, Dr. Nuñez is happy to be back in her hometown learning and growing from students at Heritage. She is especially excited to support students on their journey to becoming teachers.
