## Minutes

- 1. Call to order Morag Stewart presided. Secretary/Treasurer Ron Dalla was present. Other members present were Floyd Cloke, John Bruntlett, Wendy Repovich, Courtney Gray, and Steve Bingo. Keith Adolphson, Bob Gibbs, and Melodie Little were absent. There were no additions or changes to the agenda.

- 3. Minutes of the October 17, 2024, Board meeting were approved as presented.
- 4. Treasurer's report: Ron did not have a report for the meeting, The following information was subsequently sent to the Board members. As of 08/31/2024, the current market value is \$188,470.63, and the current principle is \$131,743.43. The Endowment scholarship fund is \$32,039.18. The STCU checking account is \$2,433.20 as of 11/21/2024.

- 6. Mark Eckerich, an alum, is the president for the Golf League. Melodie sent a thank you note to Kathy Sautells acknowledging the \$500 donation to the Golden Eagle Scholarship fund from the 2024 Golf League. The Golf League will continue.
