5. Allocation Discussion

- **a.** The group goes over the average allocations from every group member's allocation recommendation.
- **b.** The group discusses the recommended funding numbers for each request at \$3.5 million. \$3.7 million and \$3.9 million levels, and these numbers will be reflected in the voting to follow.
- **c.** Gabe Blackwell asks if the university had to go into the fund balance to fully meet the FY25 allocations, or if we got 3.7 million strictly from the mandatory fees. Nick says the balance helped meet the 3.7 million from the fiscal year 2025, but mandatory fees are still being collected.
- **d.** Student affairs may fund the food pantry separately, and academic affairs is willing to help fund the lobby day. Thus, the committee decided to cut ten thousand dollars from the food pantry and reallocate that ten thousand dollars to ASEWU for club & orgs funding, as well as helping with lobby day.
- e. The committee agreed on allocating Eagle Entertainment an extra ten thousand dollars with the stipulation that they host more events at the Spokane Catalyst Building, in lieu of fully funding the Catalyst Building's request for funding events. The committee requests Eagle Entertainment explore events at the Catalyst Building after 5 pm.

- f. The committee decides not to fund the School of Business and Accounting request because the clubs and organizations that will receive funding through this request should be requesting money from the ASEWU Clubs & Orgs budget instead. As for their request for an event-specific budget, the committee also saw this as an opportunity to fund Eagle Entertainment to host these campus events, especially at the Spokane Catalyst Building.
