FREEDOM OF SPEECH AND EXPRESSION

DO

- Peacefully assemble
- Voice your opinion
- Respect the rights of others
- Facilitate or engage in thoughtful dialogue
- Remember, EWU is constitutionally prohibited from restricting speech based on content

DO NOT

- Incite actions that would harm others
- Engage physically or threaten violence
- Expect your speech to be free from consequences or impact
- Damage or vandalize University or personal property
- Obstruct or disrupt university services, classrooms, or operations
